Competition Rules

1. All players must be under the age of 18 on the 1st January 2021 and have an active WHS handicap.
2. The completion is an 18 hole stroke play event played off the white tees for boys and red tees for girls.
3. Maximum WHS handicap index for boys is 28 and 36 for girls.
4. Entry is only through the official entry form
 - a. All entry forms must be accompanied by the entry fee of £17 (or £10 for Styal Platinum members and £14 for Gold members).
 - b. The draw will be sent via email. The draw will also be posted on the website at www.styalgolfjuniors.com on Friday 30th July
 - c. Entry fee's will only be refunded if notification is received before the closing date.
 - d. Closing date is Monday 26th July
 - e. Styal GC have the right to accept late entries in exceptional circumstances.
5. All players will play by the rules set by Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
6. Lowest net and gross players will be entered onto the national Telegraph Leader board.
7. All disputes will be settled by Styal GC whose decision will be final.
8. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by card play-off as per rules.
9. Any competitor who during the course of the event misbehaviours, for example swearing or throwing clubs or acts in a manner which bring the game into disrepute may be barred from continuing in the competition and their behaviour will be reported to their home club
10. No caddies and no supporters to be within 25 yards of players.
11. **Entries** – if entries are oversubscribed Styal GC will ballot the players based on handicap and gender. Styal members will receive a priority.
12. **Tee Times** – Approx 11.00am to 1.00pm
13. **Location** – Styal Golf Club, Station Road, Styal, Cheshire SK9 4JN
14. **Course** – Boys white tees and girls red tees.
15. **Practice** - A practice round may be booked via the pro shop 01625 531 359. Junior green fee will be applied.
16. **Registration** – Reception will be in the clubhouse. Please check in at least ½ hour before your tee time.
17. **Driving Range** – We will provide a free warm up bucket of balls, further practice balls can be purchased at the pro shop. Own balls cannot be used.

18. **Putting and Chipping Practice** – There is a practice putting green along the path the to right of the clubhouse. The first putting green is putting only, no chipping is allowed. There is also a short game practice area located beyond the first putting green across and beyond the 9th fairway/green, please take extra caution when crossing the fairway.
19. **Security** – Styal GC take no responsibility for items left in the clubhouse or changing rooms. Please secure any personal belongings in your car.
20. **Draw** – the draw will be made on Friday 30th July. It will be emailed out and posted on the website under competitions at www.styalgolfjuniors.com.
21. **Handicap** –A current active WHS handicap is required
22. **Starter** –please report to the starter at least 10 minutes before your tee time. Failure to do so could result in a 2 shot penalty.
23. **Dress Code** – recognised golf attire must be worn on the golf course. The same attire can be worn in the clubhouse. Spikes can be worn in the clubhouse.
24. **Catering** – food and drinks are available for purchase in the clubhouse.
25. **Prizes** – trophies and prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd nett and gross scores. Nearest the pin and shot of the day prizes.
26. **Presentation** – all players are encouraged to stay for the presentation. Prize winners or their representatives are expected to attend the presentation. Also a chance to win a prize in the shot of the day draw.
